Money Back

In addition to saving a lot of money spent on gas, you can get up to \$12,500 in rebates & tax credits for purchasing an EV!

- PG&E has a [Clean Vehicle Rebate Project](#), offering a \$500 rebate for the purchase of an EV.
- The [CA Clean Vehicle Rebate Program](#) offers:
 - \$1,500 - \$2,500 rebates for plug-in hybrids and fully electric vehicles*
 - Plus an additional \$2,000 rebate for low income households
- The IRS gives a [Federal Tax Credit](#) of up to \$7,500 (if you owe federal taxes)

Free Charging & Other Benefits

In addition to money back, there are other benefits:

- **Free Charging for some EV's**
 - [Nissan](#) offers up to 2 years of public charging in certain US cities
 - Tesla offers free charges at Super Charging stations all over the U.S. for S and X series models (but not the new Model 3).
- **Carpool Lane Stickers:** EVs can [drive in carpool lanes](#) even when alone

Bay Area SunShares Discounts for the 2017 Nissan Leaf

The SunShares Deal (while supplies last or until Nov. 10th, 2017):

\$34,005 2017 Nissan LEAF: Market Rate Price

-\$5,446 SunShares program discount **at Premier Nissan of San Jose** (Ask for Andreas)

\$28,559 Sun Shares Sales Price

-\$4,000 captive cash from Nissan (for purchase, must use Nissan financing)

\$24,559 Potential Net cost → \$14,059 after federal tax credit, and state & PG&E rebates

Manufacturer incentives:

- Financing is available at 0% for up to 72 months on approved credit.
- For leases through Nissan, there is \$12,350 in lease cash available.
- The 3 year (36 month lease) with the typical down payment of \$2500 comes to \$139 plus tax and license.
- Customers can receive an additional \$1000 discount if they are employed by a Nissan Vehicle Purchase Program (VPP) qualifying company.

Also, Nissan of San Francisco is offering a -\$7,000 SunShares program discount
